

The 2002 Stan Irwin Sportsmanship Award Criteria for Nomination

This award is given in honor of Stan Irwin, one of the original founders of the competition and for his dedication, unselfish sacrifice of time and self, uncommon leadership, desire to further the level of EMS care in Texas and foremost, his sense of fairness and sportsmanship that are unique to Stan. - 1) A team or individual may nominate anyone associated with the competition.
- 2) Any team or individual associated with the High Angle Rescue Competition is eligible for nomination.
- 3) Nominations must be in the form of a written statement.
- 4) The nomination must address how the team or individual's current and past contributions have added to the competition.
- 5) The nomination of the individual or team must state how, by their example, they demonstrate the attributes that best exemplify the qualities that Stan has displayed over the years.
- 6) Nominations must be turned in to any of the registration staff by 1200 (noon) Saturday, 12 October 2002.
- 7) The award will not be presented if there are no nominations.
- 8) The TRC, Inc. Board of Directors has appointed a selection committee that will review all nominations and make a selection based only upon the written statements.
- 9) The award will be presented at the Saturday evening awards presentations.
